The 45,000-square-foot [Hotel Château du Grand-Lucé](#) in France's Loire Valley is a striking example of French Neoclassical architecture. Despite its grandiosity, the former country estate of Baron Jacques Pineau de Viennay has just 17 suites (each more resplendent than the last, might we add). This gives the palatial property a sense of exclusivity and intimacy. Guests are invited to revel in the baronial atmosphere, meander through the magnificent gardens, and sip champagne in the grand salon that hosted Age of Enlightenment thinkers like Mozart and Voltaire.
